Sharon 16 years delivered twins on the 19th of April, a boy and a girl. She accepted Jesus Christ this week after delivery of these babies! She has been with us for 5 months, and in her own words she says -"I thank God so much, He has done good to me to bring me over to Wakisa Ministries, a place that have taught me how to read the word of God which I used to dislike. I and my mum drink the stuff we make and we have no time to read or hear the word of God. Here I have read it every day. It has taught me to forgive the man who raped me. I used to say that if I find him I would kill because he did a bad thing to me and I have been angry to God because He knew they raped me and He gave me twins! Now I have forgiven the boy and I know it God's plan for me to get twins. My mother and myself will take care of the twins. I have learnt how to grow vegetables and other things here in the Agriculture class by first making a nursery bed. My mother and myself have been making a living by brewing local crude alcohol. This way I get school fees and I have been doing this since I was ten, now I am going to ask my mother to stop the making of crude 'ajoni' and we concentrate on growing egg plant and collard to sell in the market and trading centres. We have a big chunk of undeveloped land which my father left my mother when he deserted me for another woman. I am the second born of the 7 children and my mother is struggling to pay school fees for us all. My mother is lame and that is why she could not come here at Wakisa. I have named the girl Vivian to remember what Wakisa Ministries has done for me".

GIRLS

The house is full with 29 girls at the center and they are generally doing well and healthy, except the one with genital warts and syphilis. She undergoing treatment and seems much better.

Three girls with HIV/AIDS are well as they take their usual doze of retro viral drugs with a strict balanced diet which fortunately is being served at the Ministry. The youngest is Darenah with full blown AIDS who was brought by an organization. She was chased away from home by her father and step mother when they found out she was pregnant. She has been harassed by the family of the boyfriend accusing her of having infected their son with HIV. She has several times wanted to run away from here but God has used the counseling and the prayers to turn her into calm forgiving open person. She is two months pregnant.

Incest: We have three incest cases. One is Ketty is 16 years old girl. She is 3 month pregnant by incest. Her mother died when Ketty was 7 years. Her dad started defiling her when she was 13 years since then he has defiling her and threatening her. She went to her auntie to tell her; the auntie could not confront Ketty's father. When she got pregnant she went to an organization that took the matter to the police and he was arrested. Ketty was brought to Wakisa and she is still angry with the father and vows never to forgive him because he did not treat her like a daughter.

The father confessed to his friend that he was advised by a

witchdoctor that he had to sleep with one of his daughters to acquire a lot of wealth!!!

There are family members including the step mother who have been coming to Wakisa Ministries to urge Ketty to withdraw the case because her father had 10 more children to look after!


Babies born and Unborn

Vocational Skills: COMPUTER SKILLS

Among the skills is a special offer for a one month Computer training by Sali Pali Computer School next door. This offer is to only 15 girls whose pregnancy is not yet advanced. They are enjoying learning the basic skills although Irene ,17 years finds the whole class too difficult to comprehend. She dropped out of school at the age of 13 when her parents died and she was left with her grandmother. When she was brought to Kampala as a house girl she got in a relationship with a gate keeper who later disappeared. Irene does not like the baby as she has nowhere to stay with the baby. We are indeed grateful to Sali Pali Director Mr. Amit for this offer.

Girls has made more maternity dresses, more candles, scarves and paper bead necklaces and paper bags in the various classes. We have placed most of these items in the gift shop.

The Agriculture lessons as well as cookery classes have taught these girls not only to grow food but how to cook it and many are really grateful for these lessons which are for a life time. The harvesting of spinach is in plenty and girls are enjoying it.

The Bible study classes have equipped girls with the knowledge of God and over 25 girls have accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

I am grateful to the staff, the volunteers and to the counselors for all their efforts to transform the spiritual and physical lives of these young girls.

I am thankful to God for His hand and presence in the work of the Ministry.

I am so thankful to you for your love and all the financial support that you give to take care of the girls and their babies.
