Fiona had a third degree perineal tear which required major surgery.


Olivia, Teddy and Margaret 16 years had babies too.

NEW ADMISSIONS

Sofia 16yrs, Brenda 15yrs, Glorious 15yrs ,Dina16yrs, Emily 19yrs and Naomi 15yrs who have been on the waiting list.

Glorious who is 5 months pregnant was going for an evening prayer and the taxi driver who took her went a different direction despite her screaming. He raped her and threw her out of the car. She was stranged and failed to find her home until late.

Glorious's left leg is lame and says she had bouts of fits at a tender age. Her parents and her sister did not believe her and threw her out of the home.

ACTIVITIES

Vocational skills training has equipped the girls with cookery, tailoring, candle making, urban agriculture, health care and handcrafts.

The new girls have adapted very well with the routine program which is a training itself.

Ella is one of the girls who has been here for 4 months now and there is a great remarkable change in her! She is no longer fighting with friends and is cooperative with the staff. She says GOD HAS SHOWN HER MERCY HERE and she wants to be called Mercy. She has shared with me what they have learnt during this month-they have learnt how to make samosas. Pancakes, pineapple jam, pineapple juice and how to prepare a meal in cookery.

In Agriculture, they learnt how to make nursery beds for cabbages and tomatoes and planted carrots. The dark house is yielding good mushrooms. The chickens are 31 and are now 2 months old.

Crafts making classes have been mainly bags made from dried palm leaves and paper bead necklaces and earrings and bangles.

In tailoring the girls are learning how to make aprons, bags, baby clothes and hand stitching.

Bible Study in Alpha course coupled with teaching understanding the bible, the content, the authors and the chronological order by Katrin Schweizer.

Katrin has aslo been teaching the girls math.

The girls also have music lessons
